- 35 houses occupied.

- Transitioned to the Red, White, Blue Program for those who move on campus.
 - Each family works with a case manager who connects them with services and helps them achieve their goals. Hives or Heroes is kicking off its second year-much excitement for this program
 - Children live in a small town, rural setting with access to recreational programs, learning opportunities, and holiday celebrations and field trips.
 - The support families receive from the National Home enables them to build a solid foundation for growth, stability, and a better future.
- Guitars For Heroes-started a new class this fall.
- The following resources/partners working with our families: VSO, Veteran Navigator, Volunteers of America Case Manager, tax professional, and employment specialist.
- The 2025-2026 Buddy Poppy Child has been selected.
- 19 kids are signed up for 4H. The program starts in March (rabbits and hogs arrive)

- Lego/Robotics nights have included 16 youth this month, and 26 people from when the supplies arrived from the STEM grant.
