So, as your Extension & Revitalization chair my duty and responsibility is to assist in instituting new or re-new Auxiliaries around the State and provide guidance to the ones that are having trouble, or on suspense and close to losing their charter. To start the year with a good footing, - there are FIVE essential items an Auxiliary must have for this year: 1) Must have at least 10 meeting /year. A quorum is FIVE (5) <u>members in good standing</u>. 2) Auxiliary should have at least 10 paid membership on or before February 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. 3) Quarterly audits by trustee must be signed, approved, and submitted to Department. 4) Must have officers elected, installed, and reported to Department Secretary by June 1<sup>st</sup> and national by June 30<sup>th</sup>. and last but not lease 5) Office of Presidents and Treasurer MUST be bonded by August 31<sup>st</sup>.
